Dear Parents/Guardians,

As we approach the end of the 2022-2023 school year, we are all looking forward to the sunny days of summer. We would like to share some information regarding summer work for students entering grades 4-8.

While summer vacation is a great opportunity for rest and relaxation, it is also important to keep our students' minds active to ensure a smooth transition back to school in the fall. The goal of our summer work assignments is to maintain students' academic skills during the summer months. There are two major areas for the summer assignments: Summer Reading and Summer Math Work. Students will receive paper copies of the materials during the final week of school. They can also access the information via Google Classroom, on the BBESNJ.org website, or stop by the main office for another copy during the summer.

## SUMMER READING

The Summer Reading information below includes a variety of age-appropriate books along with accompanying assignments designed to enhance reading comprehension. These assignments are meant to foster a love for reading while simultaneously maintaining reading stamina. Students entering grades 4-6 are asked to read one book, while students entering grades 7-8 are asked to read two books. All students are expected to turn in a graphic organizer for their book(s) on the first day of school and will complete a project about their book in September.

## SUMMER MATH

The Summer Math practice activities are skill-based assignments. The activities review the major work of the grade as they transition to their new grade level. Students should complete the practice assignments without a calculator. All Summer Math work should be turned in on the first day of school.

Estimados padres/tutores,

A medida que nos acercamos al final del año escolar 2022-2023, todos esperamos con ansias los días soleados del verano. Nos gustaría compartir información sobre el trabajo de verano para los estudiantes que ingresan a los grados 4-8.

Si bien las vacaciones de verano son una gran oportunidad para descansar y relajarse, también es importante mantener activa la mente de nuestros estudiantes para garantizar una transición sin problemas de regreso a la escuela en el otoño. El objetivo de nuestras asignaciones de trabajo de verano es mantener las habilidades académicas de los estudiantes durante los meses de verano. Hay dos áreas principales para las asignaciones de verano: Lectura de verano y Trabajo de matemáticas de verano. Los estudiantes recibirán copias impresas de los materiales durante la última semana de clases. ## LECTURA DE VERANO

La información de lectura de verano a continuación incluye una variedad de libros apropiados para la edad junto con las tareas adjuntas diseñadas para mejorar la comprensión de lectura. Estas asignaciones están destinadas a fomentar el amor por la lectura y, al mismo tiempo, mantener la resistencia a la lectura. A los estudiantes que ingresan a los grados 4-6 se les pide que lean un libro, mientras que a los estudiantes que ingresan a los grados 7-8 se les pide que lean dos libros. Se espera que todos los estudiantes entreguen un organizador gráfico para su(s) libro(s) el primer día de clases y completen un proyecto sobre su libro en septiembre.

## MATEMÁTICAS DE VERANO

Las actividades de práctica de Summer Math son tareas basadas en habilidades. Las actividades revisan el trabajo principal del grado a medida que hacen la transición a su nuevo nivel de grado. Los estudiantes deben completar las tareas de práctica sin una calculadora. Todo el trabajo de matemáticas de verano debe entregarse el primer día de clases.
