Proceso de Aplicar

- You can only apply to 1 of the vocation schools
- The applications will be received after September 1st of the applicants' 8th grade year
- Applications must be complete and supporting materials must be included
 - Grade transcript
 - Signed application by 8th grade official
 - Documentation of interest in program provided by Specialized School
- Applicant and parent **MUST** attend an information session for school of application
- Applications must be submitted by the deadline
- Solo se puede aplicar a 1 de los liceos profesionales
- Los aplicaciones sería recibido después del 1 de septiembre cuando el estudiante está en el grado 8
- Aplicaciones tiene que estar completado con las cosas siguientes
 - Archivo de todos los grados
