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2132 SCHOOL DISTRICT GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The Public School of Bradley Beach shall help every person in the district to:

- 1. Acquire basic skills in obtaining information, solving problems, thinking critically, and communicating effectively.
- 2. Acquire a stock of basic information concerning the principals of the physical, biological, and social sciences, the historical record of human achievements and failures, and current social issues.
- 3. Become an effective and responsible contributor to the decision-making processes of the political and other institutions of the community, state, country and world.
- 4. Acquire the knowledge skills, and understandings that permit him/her to play a satisfying and responsible role as both producer and consumer.
- 5. Acquire the ability to form satisfying and responsible relationships with a wide range of other people, including but not limited to those with social and cultural characteristics different from his/her own.
- 6. Acquire the capacities for playing satisfying and responsible roles in family life.
- 7. Acquire the knowledge, habits and attitudes that promote personal and public health, both physical and mental.
- 8. Acquire the ability and the desire to express himself/herself creatively in one or more of the arts, and to appreciate the esthetic expressions of other people.
- 9. Develop an understanding of his/her own worth, abilities, potentialities, and limitations.
- 10. Learn to enjoy the process of learning and to acquire the skills necessary for a lifetime of continuous learning and adaptation to change.

The Board of Education sanctions and promulgate as a guide for its policy and other determinations, the following process goals for education in the district.

POLICY

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- 1. Ensure that all instruction bears a meaningful relationship to the present or future needs and/or interests of students.
- 2. Ensure that each student has significant opportunities, consistent with his/her age, for helping to determine the nature of his/her educational experiences.
- 3. Ensure that specialized and individualized kinds of educational experiences are available for meeting the particular needs of every student.
- 4. Ensure that teachers and students have significant opportunities for participating in the decisions affecting the operations of the schools they work in or attend.
- 5. Provide guidance services of high quality for every student.
- 6. Seek to structure healthy competition among students in ways that are beneficial to them.
- 7. Ensure that the resources available for education are used with maximum efficiency.
- 8. Ensure that instructional, administrative and support staffs are of high quality in every respect.
- 9. Develop and utilize diverse forms of constructive cooperation with parents and community groups.
