



Bradley Beach Board of Education Technology Acceptable Use Agreement



Student Responsibilities:

- Students will take care of all computers and technology equipment based on common sense and according to the computer teacher’s guidelines.
- Students will not ‘chat’ online, check or send email without permission, download files, copy or alter software, order goods, access other people’s files, join a mailing list, play Internet games unauthorized by the teacher, access inappropriate material, and any other unsuitable behaviors via the Internet or other technology. Students will contact the teacher immediately if they have obtained inappropriate material, or they see someone else obtaining inappropriate material.
- All documentation acquired from the Internet needs to be cross-referenced and cited accordingly.
- Teachers have the right to review and edit student profiles in order to monitor their use.
- Teachers have the right to create accounts with online resources for educational purposes. Teachers have the right to review and edit student accounts in order to monitor their use.

Parental Responsibilities:

- As parents/guardians, we encourage you to promote good values, particularly when encountering inappropriate websites. Despite the use of filtering software and supervision, it is possible for a student to access material on the Internet that can be considered objectionable – either by accident or on purpose. It is recommended that you accept full responsibility for supervision when your child is using the Internet at home.
- Be aware of copyright laws that affect information found on the Internet. This information needs to be cited accordingly.

Any violation of this Acceptable Use Policy will result in appropriate disciplinary action and parents/guardians will be notified. Violation of this Policy shall be subject to the consequences as indicated in Regulation 2361 and other appropriate discipline which includes (but not limited to): suspension/revocation of computer/network privileges, suspension from school, expulsion from school, and/or legal action and prosecution by the authorities.
