## ADMISSION PROCESS

The admission process for incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders runs from September through January of an academic year – the fall prior to when you would be enrolling. Your candidacy for admission will be considered after completing the following steps:

1. **Attend the CBA Open House on October 14<sup>th</sup> and register for the Entrance Exam**
2. **If you cannot attend the Open House, register online for the Entrance Exam**
3. **If you can't make the Open House, schedule a personal tour to experience CBA yourself**
4. **Complete an electronic application by TBD date**
5. **Submit all school forms by November 30, 2018**

The Admissions committee will meet formally in November and December regarding decisions to accept, waitlist or deny students for admission to 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Our decisions are released in late December and students must indicate their decision to enroll by January 10, 2019. On January 24, 2019, we will hold an Enrollment Day for all students choosing to make CBA their home for high school.

## Poseidon

Applications are now being accepted for the 2019 - 2020 school year. Completed applications are due no later than **January 25, 2019**. After all applications are reviewed, applicants, whether accepted or not, will receive a letter from the Neptune Township School District informing them of their status as prospective Poseidon Early College High School students. Finalists will then be notified regarding their next steps in the acceptance process.

### Admissions Criteria

#### ***Who can apply to Poseidon?***

First generation college students who are currently in 8th grade (who will be 9th graders during the following school year) and who attend Neptune Middle School, Woodrow Wilson Elementary School, Bradley Beach Elementary School, and Belmar Elementary School, can apply for admission to Poseidon.

***What is meant by “first-generation college student”?*** “First generation” refers to students whose parents have not earned a bachelors’ degree or higher.

***What if one parent has a bachelor’s degree or higher and the other parent does not? Is a student eligible?***

No, a student is not eligible if one parent has earned a bachelor’s degree or higher.

***Why can’t a student apply to Poseidon who is not a “first-generation” college student?***

The admissions criteria at Poseidon is determined by the endowment which is funding the program and also follows the Early College High School initiative criteria set forth nationally. [poseidon application](#)
